

USER MANUAL FOR FHC ALUMINUM GRIDS

Introduction

The manual is designed to provide essential guidance for the proper use and maintenance of aluminum decorative grids.

Operation

- Aluminum grids are designed for a single application, and it is not recommended to remove and re-stick the grids multiple times as this may compromise the quality of the installation.
- Before installation, ensure that the surface where the aluminum grids will be adhered is clean, dry, and free of dust, grease or any other contamination, to ensure proper adhesion.
- After gluing the aluminum grids, be sure to apply even pressure across the entire surface to ensure proper adhesion.

Maintenance Recommendations

- Avoid exposing aluminum grids to extreme temperatures, humidity or prolonged exposure to direct sunlight, as this may affect long-term adhesion and performance.
- To clean the aluminum grids, use a soft, non-abrasive cloth moistened with water and mild detergent if necessary.
- Avoid using aggressive or abrasive chemicals that could damage the surface of the grids.
- Do not try to peel off and re-stick the aluminum grids once adhered.
- If applied to shower screens, it is recommended to install the grids only on the outside of the glass to avoid direct contact with water.
