

Frameless Shower Hardware Cleaning and Maintenance Guidelines

HARDWARE CLEANING GUIDELINES

- 1) To maintain a brilliant finish, the hardware should be dried after every use. Drying the hardware removes the water spots which are the most common culprits to damaging the finish.
- 2) A cleaning routine should be established. Clean the hardware with soapy water once a week, to assure there is no mineral deposit build up. Use a mild dish soap in warm clean water and use a soft cloth to carefully clean the hardware. Once the hardware is clean, then rinse and dry.



WARNING: Never use abrasive cleaners or chemicals to clean your hardware. Most hardware comes with a protective lacquer coating which would be damaged/destroyed by such cleaners.

GLASS CLEANING GUIDELINES:

- 1) The most successful method of keeping your new shower glass clean is to use a squeegee after every use. There is no substitute for removing the water spots by using a squeegee after every use.
- 2) Using a treatment on the glass that repels water can also be a good way of keeping the glass clean and spot-free. A water repellent such as GSP16 can greatly reduce the amount of water spots and keep the glass clean.
- 3) If the glass is neglected for too long, the water spots can become stubborn and cannot be removed with regular cleaning. In cases such as these, use BC20 Hard Water Stain Remover and the spots will come off. Then clean as usual.
